

HOW DO I REGISTER TO VOTE?

TO REGISTER TO VOTE YOU MUST:

- Be a citizen of the United States.
- Be at least 17 years old. (Although you will not be able to vote until your 18th birthday).
- You are not in jail or serving a sentence for conviction of any felony.
- You are not on parole or probation for conviction of any felony.
- You are not under a suspended sentence, probation or parole- regardless of a nolo contendere plea- for any felony committed after November 5, 1986.
- You have not been presently judged “mentally incompetent” by a court of law.

You must update your voter registration if you have:

Moved, or
Married, or
Changed your last name.

If you would like to change your party affiliation, you must change your Voter Registration Record. This is called “disaffiliation”.

You can change your registration record on the same form that is used for registering or you may have a “Disaffiliation Form” sent to you by contacting the Board of Canvassers at 728-0500, x 207 or e-mailing us at:
