Mayor's Community Meetings schedule set in Pawtucket

PAWTUCKET – Mayor Donald R. Grebien will hold a series of 22 community meetings throughout 2012 at elementary schools throughout the city as well as at City Hall.

The meetings, which Grebien launched last year during his first year in office, are offered as an ongoing opportunity for residents, business people or any member of the public to express any concerns, problems or ideas regarding the city directly to the mayor and his department heads.

The first meeting will be held on Thursday, Jan. 19 in the City Council chamber at City Hall, 137 Roosevelt Ave. Six sessions will be held in March at schools in all six districts of the city, with another six meetings at local schools again in October.

All of the Mayor's Community Meetings will start at 6 p.m. and are scheduled for Thursday evenings except the Tuesday evenings of March 13, Oct. 16 and Oct. 23. The complete schedule for the 2012 meetings is as follows.
