The City Council of the City of Pawtucket will hold a PUBLIC HEARING on the AMENDMENTS to the Proposed Annual Operating Budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022.

The amended rate of \$16.58 against the prior year equalized rate of \$16.31 represents a \$.27 increase on residential taxes. Therefore, the above amendments represent a \$.21 decrease on residential taxes to the proposed budget.

The amended rate of \$29.02 against the prior year equalized rate of \$28.54 represents a \$.47 increase on commercial taxes. Therefore, the above amendments represent a \$.36 decrease on commercial taxes to the proposed budget.

The amended rate of \$52.09 against the prior year rate of \$52.09 represents a \$0 increase on the tangible personal property. Therefore, the above amendments represent a \$0 increase on tangible personal property taxes on the proposed budget.

The amended rate of \$30.00 against the prior year rate of \$30.00 represents a \$0 increase on the motor vehicles. Therefore, the above amendments represent a \$0 increase on motor vehicles taxes on the proposed budget.
