Statewide Requirements to complete this summer/fall:

Physical Performance Assessment:

Have a valid certificate of successful completion of the Physical Performance Assessment (PPA) from the R.I. Association of Fire Chiefs issued after April 1, 2017. Note: **The PPA registration will open in August for October testing.** To register and for more information, go to the RIAFC website at: www.rifirechiefs.com.



Emergency Medical Technician:

- Possess a valid Rhode Island Emergency Medical Technician License (RI-EMT)
- Or possess a valid RI EMT-Cardiac License
- Or possess a valid RI Paramedic License
- Or have your National Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) certification and a pending RI-EMT license by the time of the oral interview in January 2018.

Minimum Requirements:

- At least 18 years of age and a U.S. citizen
- A high school graduate or possess a General Education Diploma (GED)
- A photocopy of your valid driver's license and a certified copy of your driving record, obtained from the Operator Control Office-Registry of Motor Vehicles in your state of residence
- Certified copy of your Bureau of Criminal Identification (B.C.I.) report from the Office of Attorney General in your state of residence
