The amended rate of \$52.09 against the prior year rate of \$52.09 represents a \$0 increase on the tangible personal property. Therefore, the above amendments represent a \$0 increase on tangible personal property taxes on the proposed budget.

The amended rate of \$30.00 against the prior year rate of \$30.00 represents a \$0 increase on the motor vehicles. Therefore, the above amendments represent a \$0 increase on motor vehicles taxes on the proposed budget.
